



FLOTILLA 16-01 New Member Application Checklist District 5 Northern Region - Gull Island, Pt. Pleasant, NJ

If you wish to proceed with your application to join the Auxiliary, please follow these steps. Be assured that we take the necessary precautions to safeguard your information and you should not give any forms with personal information to any other person except the fingerprint technician who has a confidentiality agreement with the Coast Guard. If you need assistance, please use the contact information provided at the bottom of this form.

STEP 1:

- Read the Auxiliary New Member Course Booklet Request one if not provided.
- Take the New Member test. If you did not receive the Auxiliary New Member Course Booklet, test questions and answer sheet, please request them via email.
- Provide the answer sheet as part of your application with your name written on the top.

STEP 2:

- Read through the Enrollment Application and fill it out on line if possible, the form is interactive. The last 2 pages are instructions and help. Be sure to read them. Go to: <http://forms.cgaux.org/forms1.php>
- Print out all pages and save them in your package **WITHOUT** signing them. Be sure to print out each page individually, **no double sided pages will be accepted**. DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING! Your signature must be witnessed by the processor. You can also fill out the application in PEN.

STEP 3:

- Copy a form of PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP, most likely your birth certificate or a recent passport. Bring BOTH original and copy to your fingerprint session.

STEP 4:

- Call or email me to arrange completion of your application. Make sure to bring all your documents. You will be fingerprinted and photographed which will be included in the package sent to Sector Delaware Bay for processing.
